The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction has provided funding for schools to give students with print disabilities unlimited access to Learning Ally's library of 80,000 audio textbooks and literature titles, including VOICEtext audiobooks that highlight text as it's being read, improving and enhancing student comprehension. Plus, schools can:

- Access Teacher Ally, a student management and book usage tracking portal
- Play books on Macs and PCs with Learning Ally's Link or on Apple and Android phones and tablets using the Learning Ally app
- Create student access accounts for use at home
- Improve student outcomes state AYP data shows that in 51 out of 52 comparisons, schools using Learning Ally services outperformed others in reading and math
