Common Challenges

- Feeling 'dumb' and stressed at school
- Feeling embarrassed about being different
- Not being able to finish on time
- Reading slowly and not understanding
- Getting your thoughts on paper
- Memorizing math facts & spelling
- Keeping track of assignments and deadlines



Accommodation Examples

- Extra time on assignments and tests
- Not reading aloud in class
- Reduced Homework
- Don't count off for spelling
- Preferential seating
- Assistive Technology (AT)



What is Assistive Technology?



Assistive Technology is a device, piece of equipment or system that helps you work around your learning challenges.

Computers, tablets, smartphones and other technologies can help.



Why do we need AT?


- Allows you to do the same work as everyone else

is <u>NO</u>!




When to start using A/T?






